

## **September 10 Technical Memorandum**

- Information to include:
  - o Population and Water Demands Reports
  - o Surface Water Availability Report
  - o Existing Water Supplies Report
  - o Identified Water Needs/Surpluses
  - o Source Water Balance Report
  - o Comparison of Availability, Supplies and Demands to the 2016 Brazos G Plan
  - Documentation of modifications to "standard" hydrologic methods WAM modifications, MAG Peak Factor, alternative yields, etc., and model input/output and processes used

Requires data entry completed in DB22

- $_{\circ}\,$  Documented process used to identify potentially feasible water management strategies
- o List of identified potentially feasible water management strategies
- o Declaration whether RWPG intends to pursue simplified planning



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- Notice Requirements:
  - o 14-day posting prior to RWPG adoption
  - o Comments accepted for 14 days following meeting
  - o Notice requirements are intended to increase awareness of intent to pursue simplified planning
- Timing to submit by Sept 10

MAG Peak Factor process may delay GW allocations

- May/June compile contractual and water supply information
- May/June water availability analyses
  - WAM analyses supplies to run-of-river rights and reservoir yield analyses
  - Groundwater allocations
  - · Allocate supplies to WUGs, WWPs
- o July database entry, preparation of memorandum
- o July 30 technical memorandum completed
- o August 6 notice posted for meeting
- o August 20 Brazos G meeting to approve technical memorandum
- o September 3 last day to take public comment
- o September 10 submit technical memorandum



## **Suggested Action:**

The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group authorizes the Brazos River Authority to request a revised deadline of November 5, 2018 to submit the Technical Memorandum, in order to complete the process for determining if a MAG Peak Factor will be used to determine available groundwater supplies in the 2021 Brazos G Regional Water Plan.
