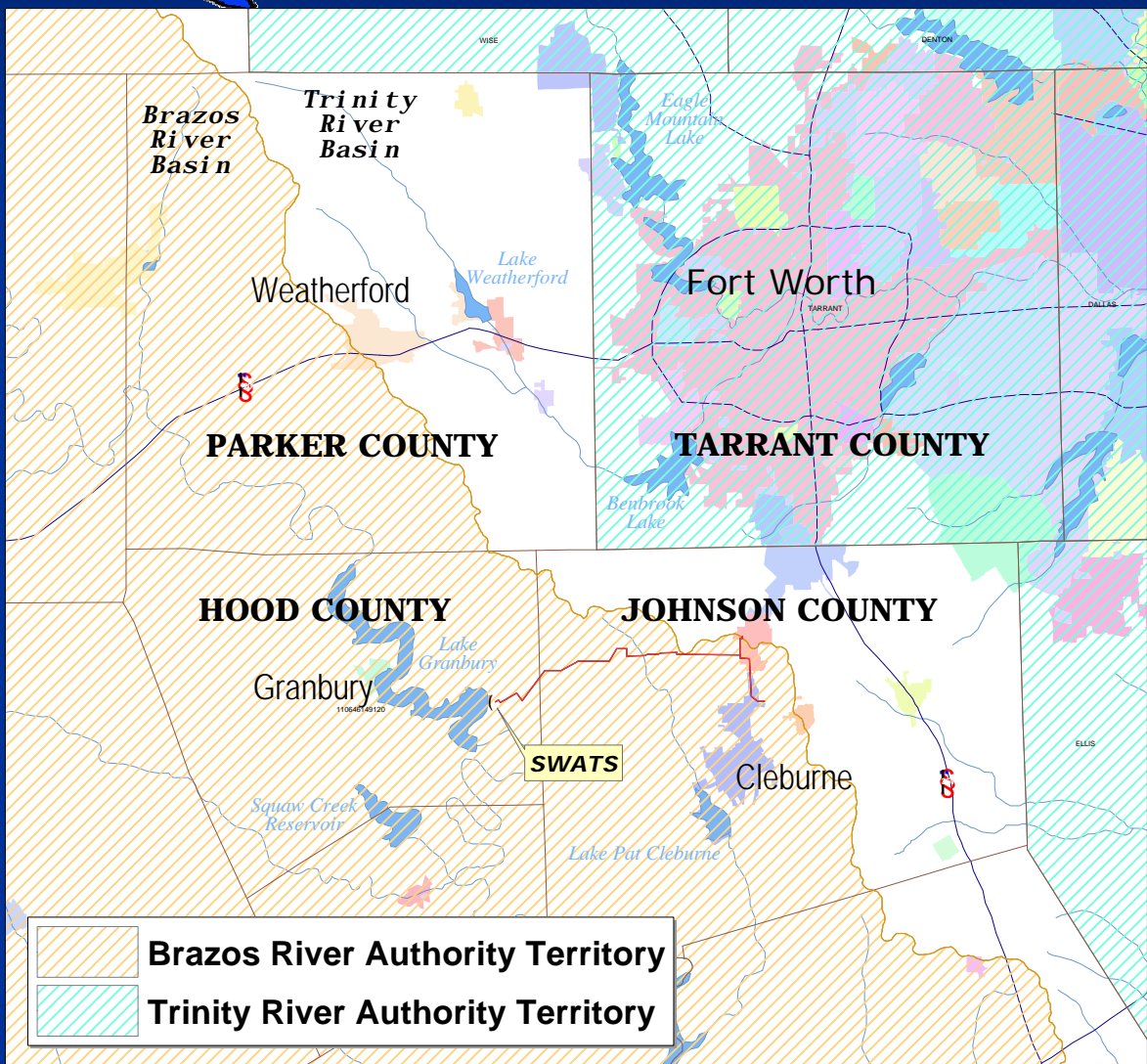

WHY PERFORM STUDY?

- Limited regional services in “No Man’s Land” between BRA Territory & TRA Territory
- Tremendous Growth Expected West and South of DFW Area
- Matching TRWD funding available
- Recommendations can be used in support of Region C & G Planning

Quick Overview of Study

- Study Sponsors include:
 - BRA - 50%
 - TRWD - 50%
- Planning Period of Study – 2003 to 2060
- Focus – evaluation of municipal and manufacturing water supply needs in Johnson/Parker County areas
- Emphasize use of combining available BRA water with TRWD water

Status Update/Next Steps

- Two Public Meetings and several Stakeholder Workshops held from January 2003 to September 2003
- Phase I Study Complete
- Phase II Scope of Work in Progress
 - Will include more detailed engineering analysis of Recommendations from Phase I Study
- Phase II to commence in FY05
- Presentation of Phase I Study Recommendations to Brazos G Planning Group expected at next available Brazos G meeting
