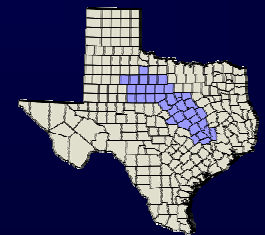

Update on Coordination with Region H

February 22-23, 2005



Background

- ✓ **Significant portion of Region H supplied from lower Brazos River Basin**
 - **Non-BRA water rights (Gulf Coast, Chocolate Bayou, etc.)**
 - **Lower basin diversions from BRA reservoir releases**
- ✓ **Task: Equitably divide BRA supply between Region H and Region G for water management strategies**
 - **Current BRA supply (constructed projects)**
 - **Allens Creek supply (30% BRA, 70% City of Houston)**
 - **Additional BRA System Operations Supply**
 - **Other water management strategies**

Update

- ✓ **HDR & BRA met with Region H consultant on January 28**
 - **Brazos G WAM supplied previously**
 - **BRA System Operations Supply**
 - **Little River and Little River Off-Channel Reservoirs**
 - **Millican (Bundic site) Reservoir**

- ✓ **HDR & BRA met February 1**
 - **Established methodology for dividing BRA supplies**

- ✓ **HDR/BRA/Region H conference call February 16**
 - **Agreed to equitable division of supplies**
 - **Pursue two joint reservoir options:**
 - ✓ **Little River Off-Channel Reservoir**
 - ✓ **Millican Reservoir**
 - ✓ **Region G needs met first – remainder to Region H**

Proposed Division of BRA Supplies as Water Management Strategies

	<u>Region G</u>	<u>Region H</u>	<u>Total</u>
Uncontracted BRA water	31,955	29,000	60,955
Allens Creek supply	0	99,650	99,650
BRA System Operations	<u>63,510</u>	<u>120,000</u>	<u>183,510</u>
Total Additional Supply from BRA	95,465	248,650	344,115
