Summary for Meeting Agenda Item 6.9 – Water Conservation Strategies**

Texas Water Development Board requirements for the development of regional water plans require that regional water planning groups consider conservation as a water management strategy to meet future needs for both municipal and non-municipal Water User Groups (WUGs).

During agenda item 6.9, HDR will present to the RWPG a brief summary of the action taken by the group in September 2004 to select water conservation strategies for municipal WUGs. Following HDR's presentation, Ken Kramer from the Sierra Club will address the RWPG on several water conservation topics. Following Mr. Kramer's presentation, HDR will present a proposed methodology for selecting water conservation strategies for non-municipal use WUGs (irrigation, manufacturing, etc.).

This information is being provided for your information, and no action is requested at this time. During the March 2005 meeting, it is anticipated that the planning group will adopt a methodology for determining water conservation strategies for non-municipal WUGs.
