TO: ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- Each mayor of a municipality with a population of 1,000 or more or which is a county seat that is located in whole or in part in the Region G water planning area;
- Each county judge of a county located in whole or in part in the Region G water planning area;
- Each special or general law district or river authority with responsibility to manage or supply water in the Region G water planning area based upon lists of such water districts and river authorities obtained from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality;
- Each retail public utility, defined as a community water system, that serves any part of the Region G water planning area or receives water from the Region G water planning area based upon lists of such entities obtained from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and
- Each holder of record of a water right for the use of surface water the diversion of which occurs in the Region G water planning area based upon lists of such water rights holders obtained from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.

PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group (BGRWPG) is considering an amendment to the 2001 Brazos G Regional Water Plan. The BGRWPG area includes the following counties: Bell, Bosque, Brazos, Burlson, Callahan, Comanche, Coryell, Eastland, Erath, Falls, Fisher, Grimes, Hamilton, Haskell, Hill, Hood, Johnson, Jones, Kent, Knox, Lampasas, Lee, Limestone, McLennan, Milam, Nolan, Palo Pinto, Robertson, Shackelford, Somervell, Stephens, Stonewall, Taylor, Throckmorton, Washington, Williamson (except the City of Austin water utilities service portion), and Young (except the City of Olney portion as follows: a rectangular area with the Northern boundary being the Archer-Young County line; the Southern boundary being a line four (4) miles south from the parallel to the Archer-Young County line; the eastern boundary being four (4) miles east of the East Olney city limits; and western boundary being four (4) miles west of the Western Olney city limits).

A summary of the proposed action to be taken includes:

The proposed action is to amend the 2001 Brazos G Regional Water Plan to meet currently changed conditions. The proposed amendment being considered includes:

“Add the permitting of additional supplies from the Brazos River System as a water management strategy for the Brazos River Authority.”

The date, time, and location of the public meeting is:

The BGRWPG shall discuss the proposed amendment to the 2001 Brazos G Regional Water Plan at its **public hearing on Tuesday, April 26, 2005**, to be held at 10:00 a.m. at the Brazos River Authority offices, 4600 Cobbs Drive, Waco, Texas. The public hearing will be held in conjunction with the BGRWPG’s April 26th regularly scheduled meeting. The BGRWPG shall consider and vote upon the proposed amendment to the 2001 Brazos G Regional Water Plan at its **public meeting on Friday, May 27, 2005**, at 10:00 a.m. at the same location listed above.

Public Comment:

The BGRWPG will accept written and oral comments from the public at the hearing listed above. The public may submit written comments separate from such hearings until **12:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 26, 2005**. Written comments should be provided to both contacts listed below:
