

Subsequent to a meeting held in Belton on March 17, 2005, to discuss population, water supply and water demand projections for entities in Bell/Coryell Counties with David Dunn from HDR Engineering, Inc., we obtained new data from Bell County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1, that indicated that the City's surface water reports which have been previously submitted to the TWDB have been incorrect since 1996.

In past years, the City of Copperas Cove has only reported water purchased from Bell County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1 and failed to include water used for production, such as, backwash water used to clean filters at the water treatment plant.

The City of Copperas Cove recognizes that at this time, population projection numbers cannot be changed, although they are still not correct, and that this issue will be dealt with at another time; we respectfully request that the City's surface water usage for the year 2000 be changed to the actual amount used as provided by the water district.

We request that our usage for the year 2000 be corrected from 2903 ac/ft to 3390 ac/ft based on actual data that we have received. We apologize for any inconvenience this error may have caused, but water supply issues are critical to the survival, growth, and economic development of Copperas Cove. Subsequent to a meeting held in Belton on March 17, 2005, to discuss population, water supply and water demand projections for entities in Bell/Coryell Counties with David Dun of HDT Engineering, Inc., we obtained new data from Bell County Water Control & Improvement District Number 1 that reflected that our surface water reports which we have been filing with the TWDB have been incorrect since 1996.

Since 1996, 439 WSC has reported only finished water purchased from Bell County Water Control & Improvement District Number 1. These reports failed to include water used for production, such as the backwash water used to clean the filters at the water treatment plant.

439 WSC recognizes that, at this time, we are not able to get our population projection numbers changed, although we feel they are incorrect. We look forward to addressing that issue at another time; however, at this time, we respectfully request that you change our surface water usage for the year 2000 to reflect the actual amount of water used, both finished water and production water.

**RE: REVISED WATER SUPPLY AND DEMAND DATA FOR
CITY OF KILLEEN IN YEAR 2000**

Dear Mr. Ward:

On March 17, 2005, a meeting was hosted in Belton by Bell County Judge Jon Burrows to discuss population, water supply, and water demand projections for water user groups in Bell and Coryell Counties. David Dunn with HDR Engineering, Inc., received new data from Bell County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1 (the "District") that demonstrated the surface water reports provided to the Texas Water Development Board are incorrect dating back to 1996.

The City of Killeen for these past years has only reported water we purchased from the District and has failed to include water used for production, such as filter backwash for the water treatment plant.

The City of Killeen recognizes that we may not be able to revise the population numbers to be used in the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan. We wish to deal with inaccuracies in these projections at a future date. However, we respectfully request that our surface water usage for the year 2000 be changed to reflect the actual amount used by the City of Killeen as provided by the District.

We request that our usage in the year 2000 be corrected from 11,682 acre feet per year to 12,966 acre feet per year based upon the actual usage data. We apologize for the inconvenience this error has caused, but we must ensure that accurate data are reported for the continued viability and economic growth of the City of Killeen. 
