**RE: April 26, 2005 Brazos G RWPG Meeting
Summary for Agenda Item 7.11 – Unique Stream Segments and Reservoir Sites**

At previous Brazos G RWPG meetings, the topics of designating stream segments having unique ecological value and sites unique for reservoir construction were discussed. HDR has recommended that no such designations be made by the Brazos G RWPG because the implications from such a designation are still unclear. The Brazos G RWPG has accepted that recommendation, pending further discussion.

Region C was considering designating a portion of the main stem of the Brazos River that crosses into Region C as a unique stream segment, but has apparently decided against that action. If it had been designated, Region C would likely have requested that Region G also designate that portion of the stream segment that is located in Region G.

The Region H RWPG has designated as unique two reservoir sites located in Region G: Little River Reservoir and Little River Off-channel Reservoir. These sites will likely be included as recommended or alternative water management strategies in the Region H plan. The Little River Off-channel Reservoir is listed as an alternative water management strategy to meet needs in Brazos County in the Draft WUG plans, but the Little River Reservoir is not identified as either recommended or alternative at this time.

HDR recommends that the Brazos G RWPG not change its current stance in spite of the recent actions of the Region H RWPG and anticipates no action by the RWPG at this time.
