**Summary for Agenda Item 7.4 – Discussion and reconsideration of the Brazos G Water Policy Issue #9 on Reuse/Return Flow presented by the Cities of Bryan and College Station.**

**Jim Mathews, Attorney (Mathews & Freeland, LLP)**, will be presenting this agenda item on behalf of both cities, Bryan and College Station. The following materials are available on the website which supplements the cities' comments to be made at the public meeting:

1. Senate Bill 1 (SB1) revisions to 11.042 of the Texas Water Code providing the procedure by which a person who discharges groundwater based return flows may obtain authorization to divert and reuse those return flows after discharge.
2. Excerpt from the House Research Organization's bill analysis for SB1 indicating that SB1 provisions concerning reuse authorization would allow cities and other entities to plan for reuse of their water after discharge.
