
Subject: Brazos G Regional Water Plan

Dear Ms. Clark:

It is our understanding that as part of your plan a lake is to be built on the Navasota River. The dam will be approximately 2 miles north of Highway 21 and the reservoir will be named Old Bundick. In reviewing the engineers' preliminary plan the maximum flood elevation would be at 312 ft above sea level. Camp Creek Lake which is located north of the OSR on FM 1940 has a normal pool elevation of 309 ft. There are approximately 400 homes on this lake. Any maximum flood elevation greater than 300 feet will create serious problems for residents of Camp Creek.

We would ask you to reevaluate the maximum flood elevation and contact us concerning your decision.
