Re: Scope of Work Development for 2011 Brazos G Regional Water Plan

Dear Dr. Mack:

We appreciate this opportunity to provide input to the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group regarding the scope of work for the 2011 Regional Water Plan. The following topics each have implications to water supply in the region and the Brazos River Authority requests your consideration for inclusion in the scope of work.

- Reservoir Reallocation – include results of on-going work of BRA and USACE on the potential water supply benefits and costs of reallocation of storage in Federal reservoirs.
- Lake Granger Conjunctive Use – expand the analysis performed in the 2006 Regional Water Plan to conjunctively use groundwater and surface water without co-mingling storage in Lake Granger.
- Reservoir Sedimentation – use latest surveys to estimate long-term sedimentation rates and future firm yield.
- Use of Brazos River Authority (BRA) System Water – for areas with projected shortages, include consideration of BRA system water supplies piped from the main stem, including potential supplies to Comanche, Limestone, and Johnson county areas.

Since each of these topics was included to some degree in the July 2006 materials considered by the Brazos G Scope of Work committee, I have been brief in my description of them here. Brad Brunett and/or David Wheelock will be available at the upcoming meeting to provide additional information at your request.
