Re: Public Comment for April 16, 2008 meeting

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am a water rights holder and request that my comments be read and considered by the Regional Water Planning Group.

I have had occasion to observe the river, known as Little River most of my life.

Never before have I seen the silt and particulate matter that is in the water.

This is caused by no conservation practices being maintained and by the excessively high discharges of water over extended periods of time.

Another serious problem is that erosion has been so extensive that many people can no longer water livestock in the river or fish in the river because they cannot safely access the river. High eroded banks are hazardous to humans and hazardous to livestock.


Since the dams were put in on the Leon and Lampasas rivers, we are experiencing greater soil erosion and environmental damage than we had ever experienced before. My earliest experience on the river goes back to the early 1930's and the destruction that has been done since the dams were put in and the discharge of waters surpasses anything I have ever seen before.

I request that conservation and environmental action be put into place at an early date.

I also request that I be informed of what soil and water conservation and environmental planning has been put into place since the dams were put in.

Your consideration of this vital matter is appreciated.
