Dear Mr. Buzbee:

Parker County SUD has submitted an application for funding for a 1.0 MGD water treatment plant on the Brazos River. The project is not currently included in the Region G Water Plan and we are, therefore, requesting a consistency waiver.

The project includes the construction of a 1.0 MGD water treatment plant near Dennis, Texas to treat water out of the Brazos River. This supply is intended to supplement other supplies for Parker County Special Utility District. The raw water supply is already in place through a contract with the Brazos River Authority. The SUD's service area includes much of the portion of Parker County west of the City of Weatherford. The service area is included in the Region G water plan even though it overlaps both the Brazos River and Trinity River basins. The Region G plan currently includes supply for Parker County Other from the City of Mineral Wells. The SUD has been negotiating with the City of Mineral Wells for additional water supply for many years without success. In addition, the City of Mineral Wells supply is limited. The Brazos River was not identified as a viable alternative by the SUD until recently and so it was not previously requested that it be included in the regional plan.
