Jackie has a superior understanding of the needs of cities and would be a very active and responsible member and valuable resource for you.

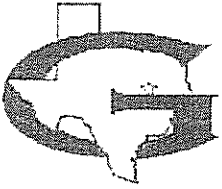

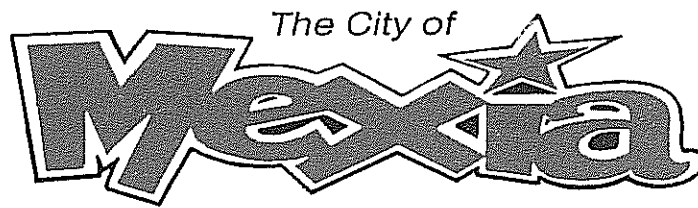
