Issue #7: Conjunctive Use of Groundwater and Surface Water

“The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group ([Brazos G](#)) recognizes conjunctive use as an important management strategy. Conjunctive use is the systematic [utilization](#) of groundwater with surface water to optimize the combined yield from both sources. Conjunctive use seeks to maximize the advantages and minimize the disadvantages of each source when both are [utilized](#) together. As conjunctive use projects are recognized, they should be included as management strategies for the regional water plan. Brazos G encourages development of alternative conjunctive use projects, including aquifer storage and recovery operations, as needed.”
