

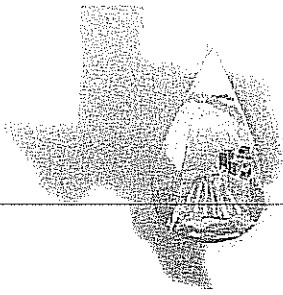


Please accept this as a letter of support for the appointment of Robertson County Judge Jan Roe as a voting member of the Brazos G Water Planning Group.
