Types of Revisions

- ✓ **Non Substantial Changes (no specific action)**
 - **Editorial corrections and clarifications**
 - **Refinement of cost estimates**
 - **Refinement of supply estimates**
- ✓ **Substantial Changes (specific action)**
 - **Removal/addition of water management strategies**
 - **Significant modifications of strategy evaluations (none)**
 - **Changes to WWP status**
 - **Additions to Plan (IFR survey and Water Loss Audits)**
 - **DB12 Issue**

Revisions to the 2011 IPP

- 1. Remove Millican Reservoir as a recommended water management strategy for the Brazos River Authority.**
- 2. For the City of College Station:**
 - a) Remove Millican Reservoir as a recommended water management strategy.**
 - b) Add BRA System Operations Permit supply as a recommended water management strategy.**

Revisions to the 2011 IPP

- 3. Define City of Bryan as a Wholesale Water Provider.**
- 4. Add supplies from Bryan as a recommended water management strategy for Wickson Creek SUD.**
- 5. Change the recommended water management strategies for Bell County WCID No. 1:**
 - a) Remove “Reallocate Supplies between Contractual Customers”.**
 - b) Add “Firm up Existing BRA Supplies with Lake Granger Augmentation”.**
 - c) Add reuse strategies requested by Bell County WCID No. 1.**

Revisions to the 2011 IPP

- 6. Add reuse supply from Bell County WCID No. 1 as a water management strategy for the Cities of Killeen and Harker Heights.**
- 7. Remove Lake Granbury supply as a recommended water management strategy for the City of Cleburne.**
- 8. Request that the TWDB remove the term “(includes overdrafting)” from the water planning database DB12 for each recommended water management strategy that involves the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer in a county where the aquifer will not be over allocated.**

Revisions to the 2011 IPP

- 9. Authorize inclusion of Section 1.12, summarizing water loss audit information for Brazos G entities.**
- 10. Incorporate survey results from the Infrastructure Financing Survey into Section 9 of the 2011 Plan.**
