The City of Granbury, Texas is in the process of designing a new Surface Water Treatment Plant (SWTP). The proposed SWTP will initially treat up to 1.5 MGD and will be a much needed improvement to the city's aging plant currently in operation and will allow the City to release their treatment capacity in the BRA SWATS plant.

This letter is a formal request to be placed on the agenda of the Regional Water Planning Group's February meeting. The topic of discussion will be an amendment to the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan to include the proposed SWTP.
