- **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group that the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan is hereby amended by adopting a new Somervell Steam-Electric water supply plan to address a projected shortage for Somervell County Steam-Electric of 36,047 acre-feet per year in 2030 and 36,107 acre-feet per year in 2060.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group approves to submit to the Texas Water Development Board a request to revise Somervell County Steam-Electric water demands in the 2006 Brazos G Regional Water Plan from 23,200 acre-feet per year to 84,817 acre-feet per year.
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group directs the Brazos River Authority to coordinate with the Texas Water Development Board to ensure that the recommended water management strategy and revised Steam-Electric water demands are included in the 2007 State Water Plan.
