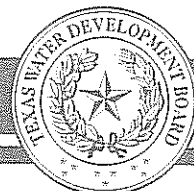

Staff at the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) reviewed your two requests dated August 25, 2009 for approval of water supply methodologies for the 2011 Brazos G Water Plan Update. As mentioned in your request, Region G will use two-year safe yields for the determination of surface water supplies from Fort Phantom Hill and Hubbard Creek Reservoirs.

The TWDB approves the use of this methodology for development of the 2011 regional water plan. Please note that the contract between TWDB and the Brazos River Authority requires that firm yields also be included in the 2011 regional water plan.
